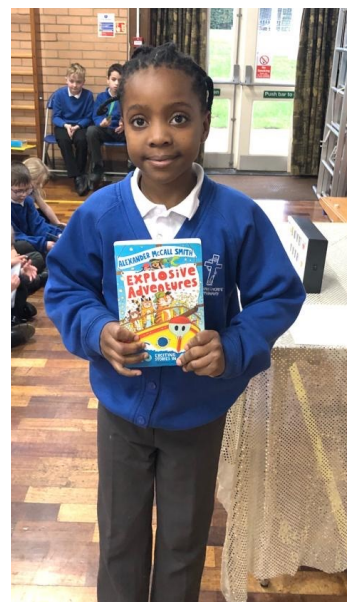
Dear Parents,

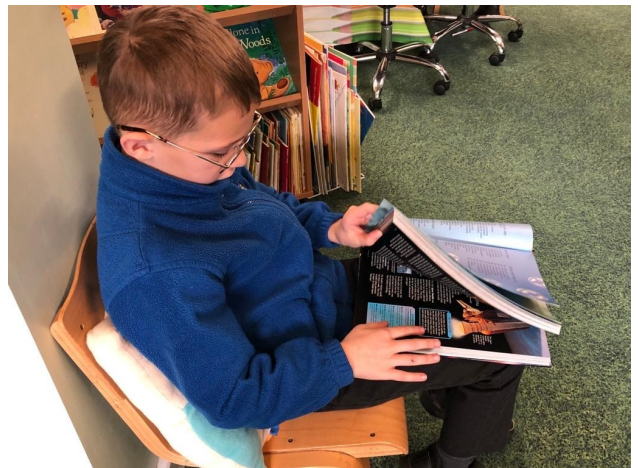

Reading is the key to success.



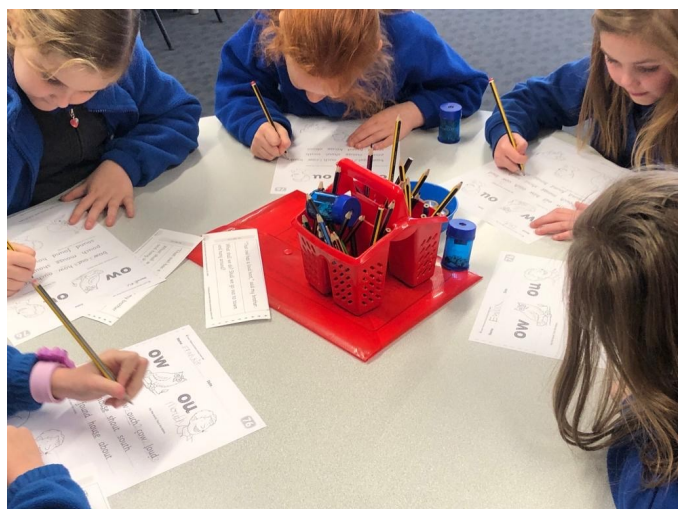
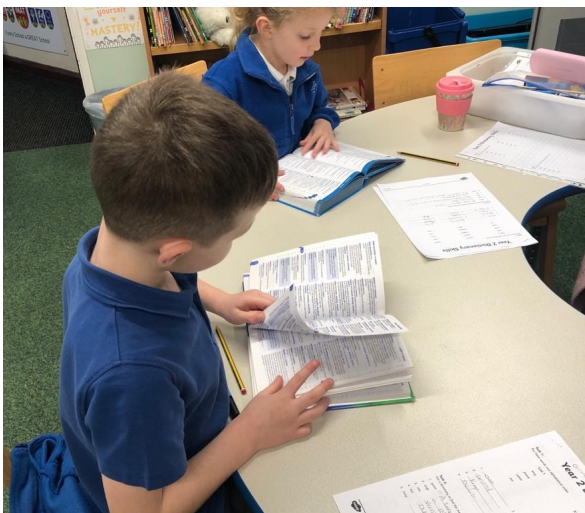
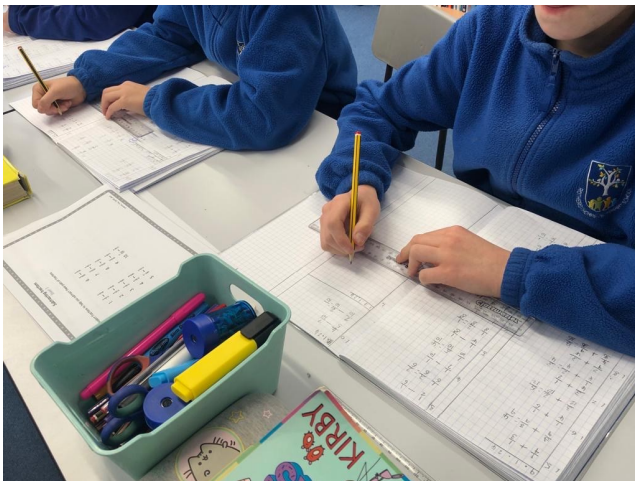
Our School Well-being Area
