It was decided that for classes 2, 3 & 4 —10 ClassDojo points will equate to 1 sticker on their achievement card. All classes will still continue to earn stickers on their achievement cards for work in school. Mrs Henry-Moore will ensure Class 1 do not miss out, as they do not have ClassDojo. So, there are two opportunities for children to fill up their achievement cards.

During Friday achievements assembly children can bring their filled cards and receive a small prize for each card and points for their house team.
